10 Requesting the Joint Committee on Government and Finance authorize  
11                a study on repealing unnecessary or obsolete boards, councils,  
12                committees, panels, task forces and commissions.

13                WHEREAS, The Legislature is committed to promoting efficiency  
14 in government by regularly evaluating programs, boards and  
15 commissions to determine if they have accomplished their intended  
16 purpose or are not functioning in accordance with the Code of West  
17 Virginia; and

18                WHEREAS, It is necessary from time to time to update the Code  
19 of West Virginia by eliminating unnecessary or obsolete boards and  
20 commissions; therefore, be it

21                *Resolved by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

22                That the Joint Committee on Government and Finance is hereby  
23 requested to study repealing unnecessary or obsolete boards,  
24 councils, committees, panels, task forces and commissions; and, be  
25 it

26                *Further Resolved,* That the Joint Committee on Government and  
27 Finance report to the regular session of the Legislature, 2015, on  
28 its findings, conclusions, and recommendations, together with  
29 drafts of any legislation necessary to effectuate its

2       *Further Resolved*, That the expenses necessary to conduct this  
3 study and to prepare and draft necessary legislation be paid from  
4 legislative appropriations to the Joint Committee on Government and  
5 Finance.
